We are planning another TIM Train-the-Trainer program in October. We are currently looking for a location in the western portion of the WisDOT SWR to hold this class. Recently, I participated in an online FHWA TIM T-t-T course where we were given an update on the progress of the new TIM modules. These modules will be completed in 2023 and will include a module on electric vehicles. In addition, they have developed a 1-hour rural TIM module that can be integrated into the normal 4-hour training program. A 1.5-hour instructor course will accompany these changes. One last update on this topic, FHWA is developing a 1-hour TIM recertification course with a projected release in 2024.

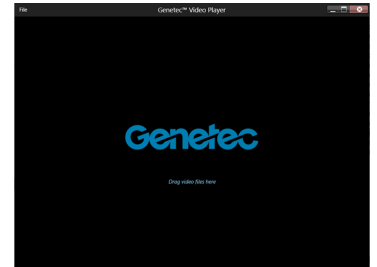
Traffic Management Center's New Video Management System

WisDOT's Traffic Management Center (TMC) will soon implement a new Video Management System (VMS). What does this mean for you? If you have previously requested video from the TMC, you are familiar with our current video file format and player. As we switch to the new VMS, video requests from the TMC will be sent in a new file format and with a new player. We encourage you to please visit the link below to download a copy of the Genetec File Player and test video file so you can get familiar with the new format prior to the rollout. You may need to work with your IT staff to ensure the new player will work correctly on your systems. It's important that the requested video is played with the included file player to preserve date and time stamps and to ensure the integrity of the original file.

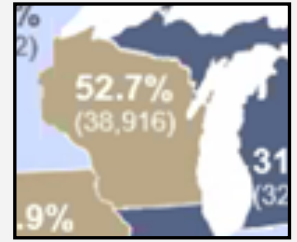

WisDOT Connected and Automated Vehicles (CAV) Update

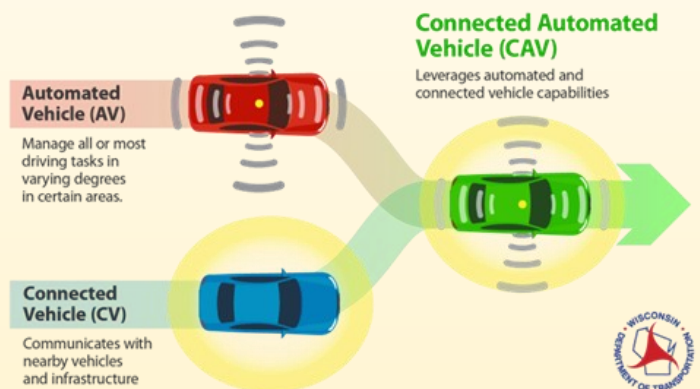
WisDOT has launched a redesigned CAV website to provide basic information about CAVs and how the state is getting prepared for these new technologies. It also includes links to more in-depth resources for those who are interested.

This website works to make CAV information readily available to various stakeholders, including Wisconsin's first responders. Information for first responders was developed, in part, from responses of TIME members to the WisDOT 2021 CAV survey.

Some areas of particular interest to first responders include: the sample of the **Law Enforcement and First Responders Training file** included under the *Law Enforcement and First Responder* page, and information on a **Work Zone Data Exchange** research project and an **Automated Truck Mounted Crash Attenuator** test project intended to improve the protection of mobile work crews, both located on the *Infrastructure Planning* page.
