

Ordinance to Totally Opt Out of IOH Length and Weight Limits


Whereas, 2013 Wis. Act 377 under Sec. 348.27 (19)(b)5.a. provides that a municipality may authorize implements of husbandry as defined in Sec. 340.01 (24) and agricultural commercial vehicles as defined in Sec. 340.01 (1o) of Wis. Statutes to exceed any statutory length and weight limits imposed by Chapter 348 of Wis. Statutes,

Now, therefore, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED by the Town Board of Courtland, of Columbia County, that pursuant to Sec. 348.27 (19)(b)5.a. of Wis Statutes, implements of husbandry and agricultural commercial vehicles as defined by Chapter 340 of Wis. Statutes may exceed any length and weight limits imposed by Chapter 348 of Wis. Statutes.


Further, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED that this ordinance shall remain in effect until rescinded by further action of the board.
