ORDINANCE
No. 2014-01

Implements of Husbandry (IOH) and Agriculture CMVs

Whereas, 2013 Wis. Act. 377 under Sec. 348.27(19)(b)5.a. provides that a municipality or county may authorize implements of husbandry as defined in Sec. 340.01 (24) and agricultural commercial vehicles as defined in Sec. 340.01(10) of Wis. Statutes to exceed any statutory length and weight limits imposed by Chapter 348 of the Wis. Statutes.


Now, therefore, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED by the Town Board of Weirgor, in Sawyer County, that pursuant to Sec. 348.27 (19)(b)5.a. of Wis. Statutes, implements of husbandry and agricultural commercial vehicles as defined by Chapter 340 of Wis. Statutes may exceed any length and weight limits imposed by Chapter 348 of Wis. Statutes on Weirgor Town roads.

Further, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED that EXCEPTION to the above mentioned excessive weight limits is during times where seasonal weight limits, commonly referred to spring break-up, are in effect or when otherwise posted by the Weirgor Town Board.

Further, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED that this ordinance shall remain in effect until rescinded by further action of the board.

Further, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED that a copy of this ordinance shall be provided to the Wisconsin Department of Transportation to be posted on the D.O.T. website.


