ORDINANCE NO. 2014-4

ORDINANCE TO TOTALLY OPT OUT OF IOH LENGTH AND WEIGHT LIMITS

The Viroqua Town Board of Vernon County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

Whereas, 2013 Wisconsin Act 377 under Section 348.27 (19)(b)5.a. provides that a municipality or county may authorize implements of husbandry as defined in Section 340.010(24) and agricultural commercial vehicles as defined in Section 340.01(10) of Wisconsin Statutes to exceed any statutory length and weight limits imposed by Chapter 348 of Wisconsin Statutes.

Now, therefore, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED by the Viroqua Town Board, that pursuant to Section 348.27(19) (b)5.a. of Wisconsin Statutes, implements of husbandry and agricultural commercial vehicles as defined by Chapter 340 of Wisconsin Statutes may exceed any length and weight limits imposed by Chapter 348 of Wisconsin Statutes, except as may be restricted by seasonal, special postings or bridge and culvert limits.


Further, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED that this ordinance shall remain in effect until rescinded by further action of the Viroqua Town Board.





OPTIOPN B – TOTAL OPT OUT OF IOH LENGTH AND WEIGHT LIMITS

Effect of Option B: Adoption of this ordinance pursuant to Section 348.27(19)(b)5.a. of Wisconsin Statutes (as provided by 2013 Wisconsin Act 377) means that the governing body of a municipality or county authorizes operation, on all highways under their jurisdiction, implements of husbandry as defined in Section 340.01(24)(see Act 377) and agricultural commercial vehicles as defined in Section 340.01(10)(see Act 377) to operate in excess of any length and weight limitations imposed by Chapter 348 of Wisconsin Statutes. However, all implements of husbandry and agricultural commercial vehicles are still bound to follow seasonal and special postings and any postings and any postings on highway bridges or culverts under Section 349.16 of Wisconsin Statutes.
