  - a. Difficult to enforce specification in urban areas around utilities and intersections. Consider adding restrictions on using the specification in urban settings.
  - b. In past few months, bid items were listed by the ton instead of each.
  - c. **Action-** conduct cost comparison for projects with and without base compaction bid items.

## 2. FDM updates

- a. Implementation plan presented
  - i. Short term Increase number of projects. Minimum tonnage of 10,000 tons.
  - ii. Long term add to standard specification.
- b. **Action-** revise guidance in FDM for how to estimate the number of layers for base compaction.
- c. **Action** draft guidance about how to set-up lots for staged construction; how to estimate quantities for certain types of typical sections.

  - a. Include base compaction in potential aggregate inspection training program.
