Purpose

The purpose of the project is to maintain and improve an important roadway within the local transportation system by addressing deficiencies along this segment of WIS 23.

Project information

We are proposing to improve approximately seven miles of WIS 23.



Proposed improvements include:

- Replace pavement surface along the entire project area.
- Widen paved shoulder to 5 ft. to accommodate pedestrians and bicyclists from 10th Avenue to the City of Montello
- Add centerline rumble strips and safety edge along the entire project area.
- Add shoulder rumble strips from 10th Avenue to the City of Montello
- Replace and update signage and pavement marking.
- Replace deteriorating culverts.

This project will provide improved conditions and increased accessibility for motorists and pedestrians/bicyclists with the addition of rumble strips, wider paved shoulders, and updated signage. Replacing pavement along this segment of WIS 23 is also a cost-effective solution to extending the lifespan of the roadway.

Proposed traffic impacts

During construction, the roadway will be open to traffic with flagging operations. Motorists can expect to encounter slower travel speeds and lane closures during culvert replacement work and paving operations.

Real estate

No real estate acquisition is anticipated.
