Purpose of this handout

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is seeking public feedback for proposed improvements on I-41 in Fond du Lac County. The purpose of this outreach is to obtain your input on the identified needs and proposed improvements along I-41 in the project limits. There will be no in-person public meeting due to the current health emergency. We appreciate your input and encourage you take a moment to review the project information and provide comment.

Project location and limits

This project is located on I-41 in Fond du Lac County between the south county line and the interchange with US 151.



Project need

WisDOT is proposing to improve 6.75 miles of I-41. The existing pavement and cable guard system are both beginning to deteriorate and will require increased maintenance. They are anticipated to reach the end of its service life by the time of construction.

Proposed improvements

- Mill and overlay of the existing pavement on the northbound and southbound lanes of I-41 and the interchange ramps with County B
- Median cable guard replacement
- Beam guard replacements
- Culvert replacements

Anticipated traffic impacts

Construction is currently scheduled for 2023.

During construction, there will be a detour. Traffic will be detoured onto WIS 175 during culvert replacements and while the County B interchange ramps are being resurfaced. Much of the work is anticipated to be at night or during off peak hours.

Real estate needs

There is no right of way acquisition anticipated for this project.

Project update/next steps

The design process for this project is expected to conclude in 2022, with construction tentatively scheduled for 2023. The environmental review is scheduled to be completed in winter 2021.

Public input/comments


