Purpose of the Meeting

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is seeking public feedback on the project rehabilitation of US 41 in Marinette County. The purpose of this outreach is to obtain your input on the identified needs and proposed improvements along US 41 from approximately 2,800 feet west of Flame Road in the town of Peshtigo to near West Cleveland Avenue in the city of Marinette. There will be no in-person public meeting. We appreciate your input and encourage you take a moment to review the project information and provide comments.

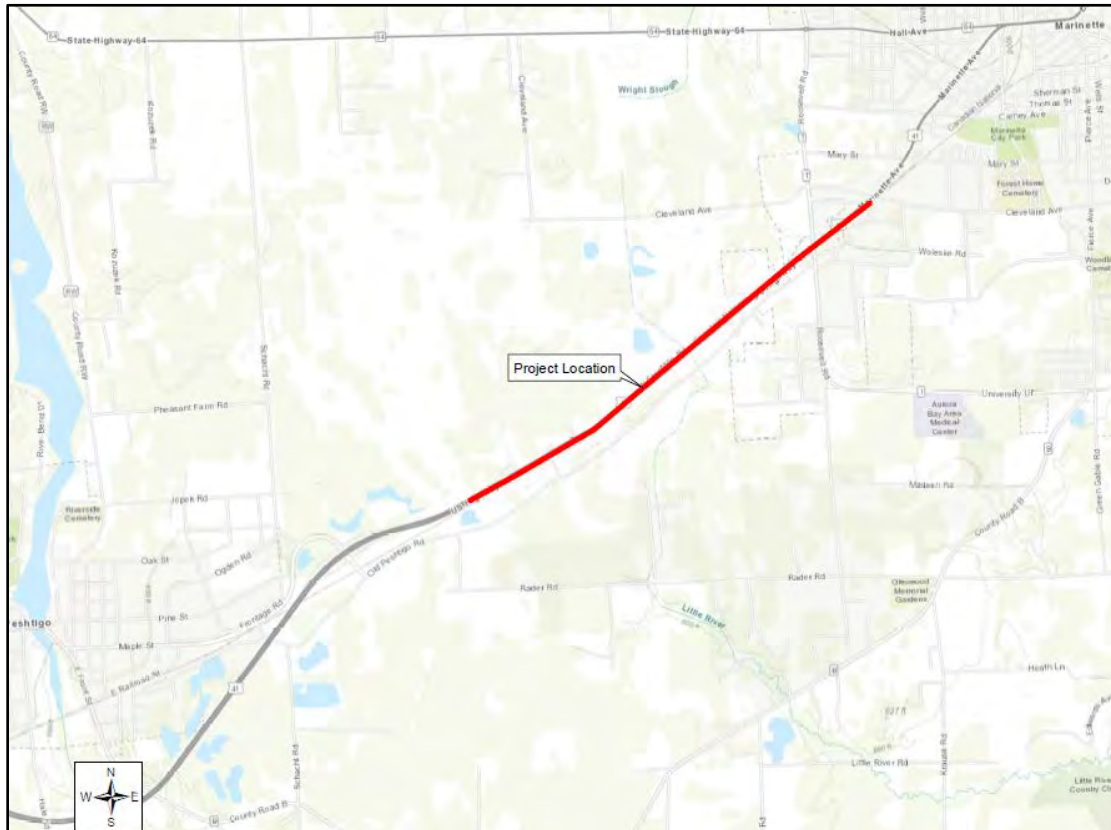
Project Information

WisDOT is proposing to improve 2.7 miles of US 41. The proposed project is a resurface level improvement project. The purpose of the project is to improve the deteriorating pavement and drainage structures and to extend the roadway's service life.

Proposed improvements include:

- Concrete repair and asphalt resurfacing of mainline US 41
- Replace guardrail
- Replace culverts at three locations
- Pavement markings
- Adjust inlets where appropriate
- Spot curb and gutter replacement

Proposed Traffic Impacts

Construction is scheduled to begin in 2024.

If funds are available, the project could occur in 2023.

During construction, the roadway will be open to traffic and US 41 will be reduced to one lane of traffic in each direction. Temporary driveway closures will be necessary during parts of the construction process. WisDOT will contact homeowners and businesses in advance before closing a driveway.

Real Estate

No right of way is anticipated as part of the project.
