
Purpose of the handout

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is seeking public feedback on the below design proposal for construction on WIS 29 in Brown County. The purpose of this outreach is to obtain your input on the identified needs and proposed improvements along WIS 29 between the west county line to County J in Brown County. We appreciate your input and encourage you take a moment to review the project information and provide comment.

Project information

WisDOT is proposing to improve 7.97 miles of WIS 29. The project is a resurface-level improvement project. The purpose of this project is to address deteriorating pavement and other roadways' deficiencies including curb ramps, guardrail and culverts along WIS 29 from the west county line to County J. Construction is scheduled for 2028 but could start as early as 2025 if funding becomes available.

Proposed Improvements

WisDOT is proposing a resurface-level improvement project on the 7.97 miles of WIS 29 between the west county line and County J. Improvements include:

- Resurfacing mainline WIS 29 (asphalt mill and overlay)
- Resurfacing ramps for WIS 32 and resurfacing mainline WIS 32 (asphalt mill and overlay)
- Replacing beam guard
- Replacing curb ramps on County FF north of WIS 29
- Replacing culvert endwalls
- Replacing two culverts on WIS 29 near County VV
- Cleaning culverts
- Pavement markings
- Adding shoulder rumble strips
- Shoulder aggregate

Proposed traffic impacts

WIS 29 will remain open for travel during construction. Motorists can expect to encounter temporary lane and shoulder closures. The ramps for WIS 32 will be closed for 3 days or less during resurfacing operations. More than one ramp on the interchange will not be closed at the same time.

During the replacement of two culverts on WIS 29, one direction of WIS 29 will be closed. Traffic will use the ramps at County VV to exit and then reenter WIS 29.
