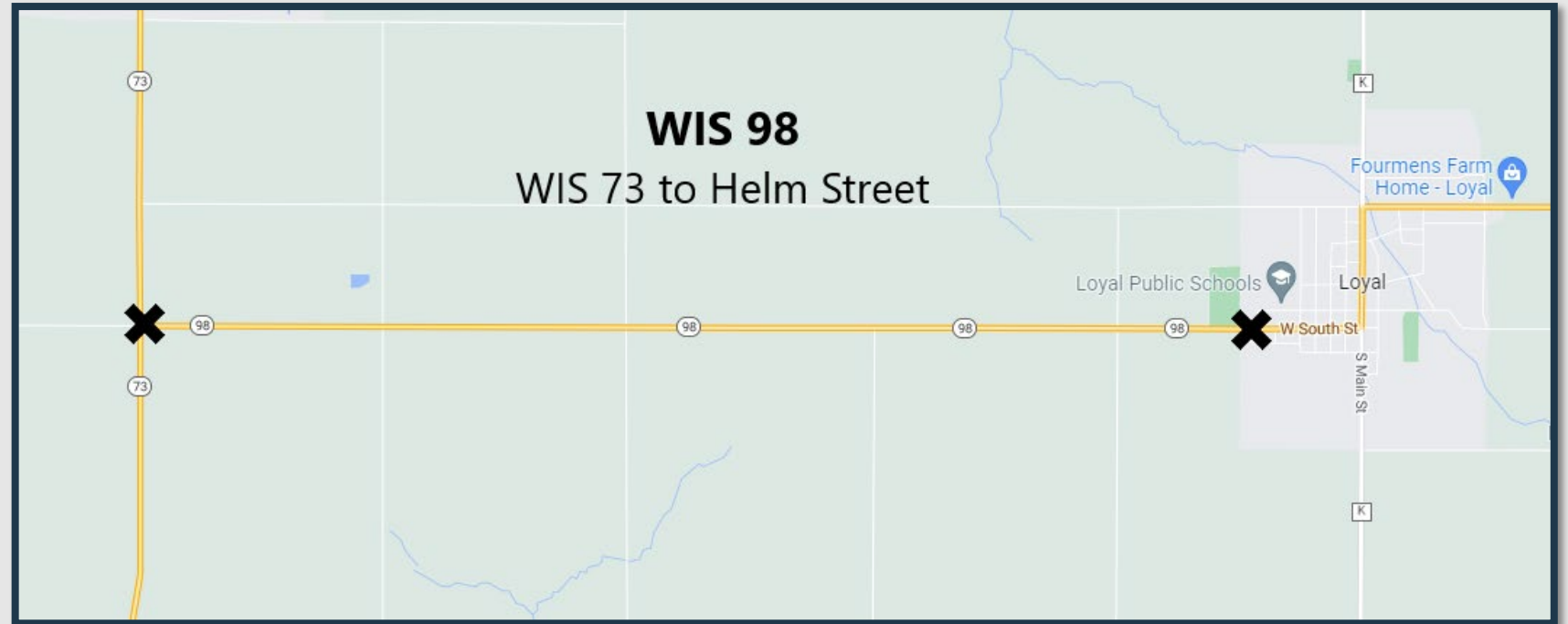
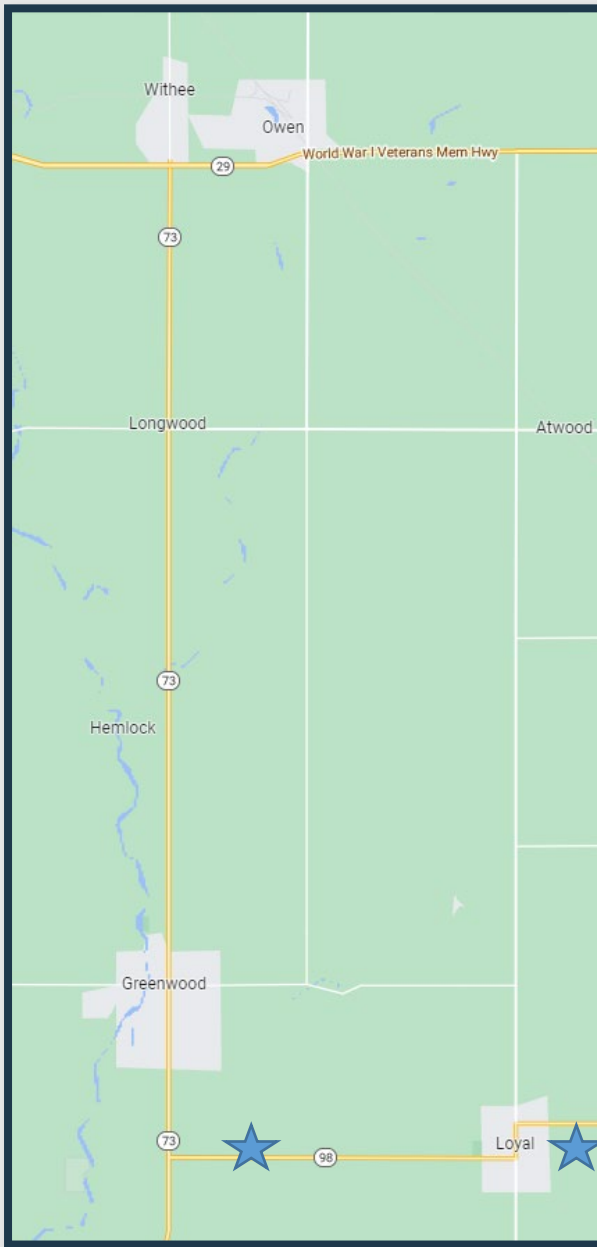

Project Location



Purpose and Need

- Purpose
 - To preserve the function, operation and safety of the route
- Need
 - To repair the concrete surface of the road and culverts



Proposed Improvements

- Replace existing concrete pavement, base material and geo-grid in poor soil areas.
 - Project length: 4.49 miles
 - New pavement thickness: 7 inches
- Make joint and centerline repairs where necessary.
- Clean or repair culverts to improve drainage.
- Replace pavement markings.





Traffic Impacts

- During construction, motorists can expect:
 - Single-lane closures controlled by flagging operations or temporary traffic signals for the majority of work.
 - Single-lane traffic controlled by temporary signals during concrete replacement in areas showing high distress.



Project Timeline

- Now until Oct. 21, 2022
 - Public comment submission
- Oct. 31, 2022
 - Final environmental document submission
- March 1, 2024
 - Final plans, specifications and estimates submission
- 2025 or 2026
 - Construction
