



WIS 190 (Capitol Drive) Improvement Project Waukesha County

Project Overview

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is planning to make improvements to a 1.7-mile long section of WIS 190 (Capitol Drive) in the Village and City of Pewaukee. The project extends from WIS 16 to approximately 1,500 feet east of Five Fields Road (see next page for project location). This newsletter provides an update on the proposed project and instructions for providing comments on the proposed design. All persons having an interest in the project are encouraged to provide comments by September 18, 2023 using the attached comment form. Purpose and Need

The purpose of the project is to address the deteriorating pavement condition and decreased ride quality along WIS 190, as well as to address outdated traffic signal equipment. The project will provide a safer driving surface on WIS 190 as well as update traffic signals to current standards.

Summary of Proposed Improvements

A combination of replacing the deteriorated concrete pavement section and resurfacing the asphalt pavement section will be used to restore the road's structural integrity and extend its life cycle. The proposed improvements include the following:

- Replace the concrete pavement structure from approximately 350 feet west of WIS 16 to approximately 750 feet west of the Forest Grove Drive/Georgetowne Drive intersection
- Resurface the asphalt pavement from approximately 750 feet west of the Forest Grove Drive/Georgetowne Drive intersection to approximately 1,500 feet east of Five Fields Road
- Add traffic signals and improve the WIS 16 westbound off-ramp intersection
- Replace traffic signals at the five existing signalized intersections within the project limits
- Upgrade curb ramps to meet current ADA standards

No new right-of-way acquisition is anticipated.

Proposed Traffic Impacts

WIS 190 will remain open to a single lane in each direction during construction. Short-term closures of the WIS 16 ramps are anticipated. The construction contractor will be required to maintain access to local businesses and property owners. Construction is currently anticipated for 2024.
