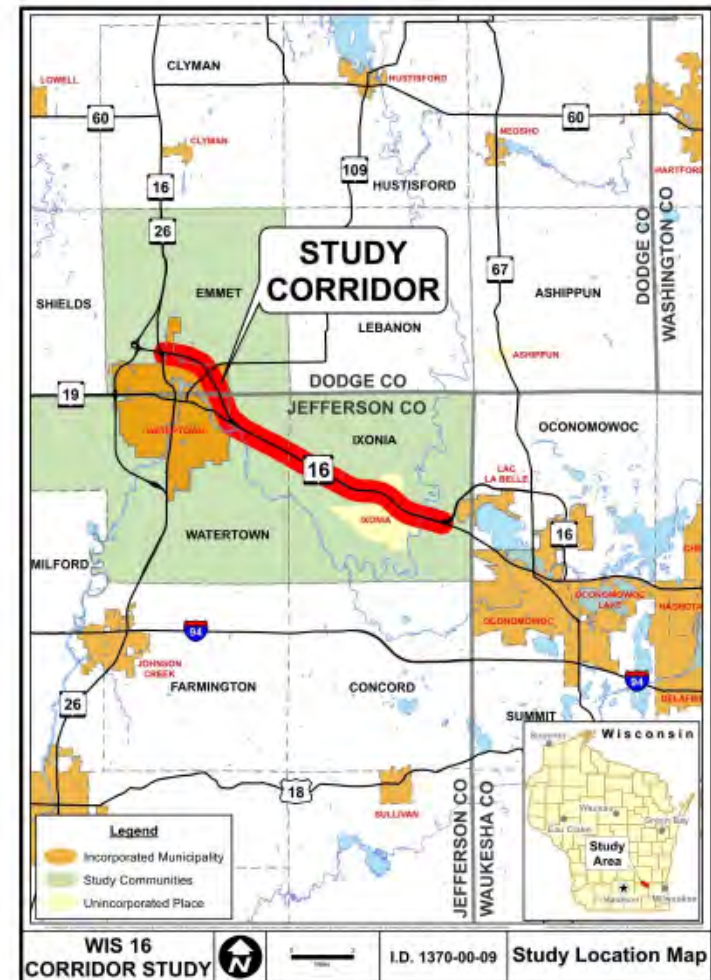


WIS 16 Corridor Study

WisDOT studied the WIS 16 corridor to develop a long-range plan to safely manage, preserve, and extend the useful life of the WIS 16 corridor.

The final study report:

- evaluates the existing conditions
- identifies deficiencies
- identifies areas of concern
- explores conceptual improvements
- includes a long-term WIS 16 highway access management plan

This study:

- documents current and future corridor conditions (safety and operational)
- raises awareness of safety concerns for further consideration
- suggests roadway concepts for further consideration
- provides a comprehensive report to assist WisDOT and municipalities with long range planning of land use and transportation

This study does NOT:

- include any considerations for highway capacity expansion (addition of lanes along this corridor)
- immediately initiate design or construction projects
- provide funding or approval for design or construction projects
- initiate land purchases
- initiate access changes

This study is NOT related to:

- the County F intersection project in Ixonia
- the WIS 26 project near Watertown
