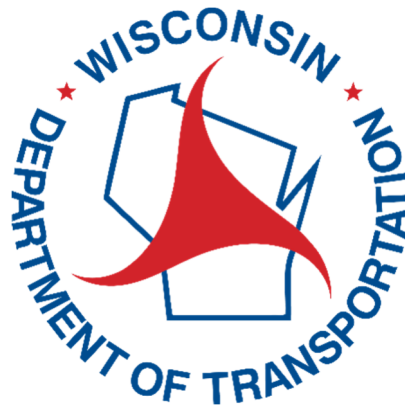


# Public Involvement Meeting Handout

## Purpose of the meeting

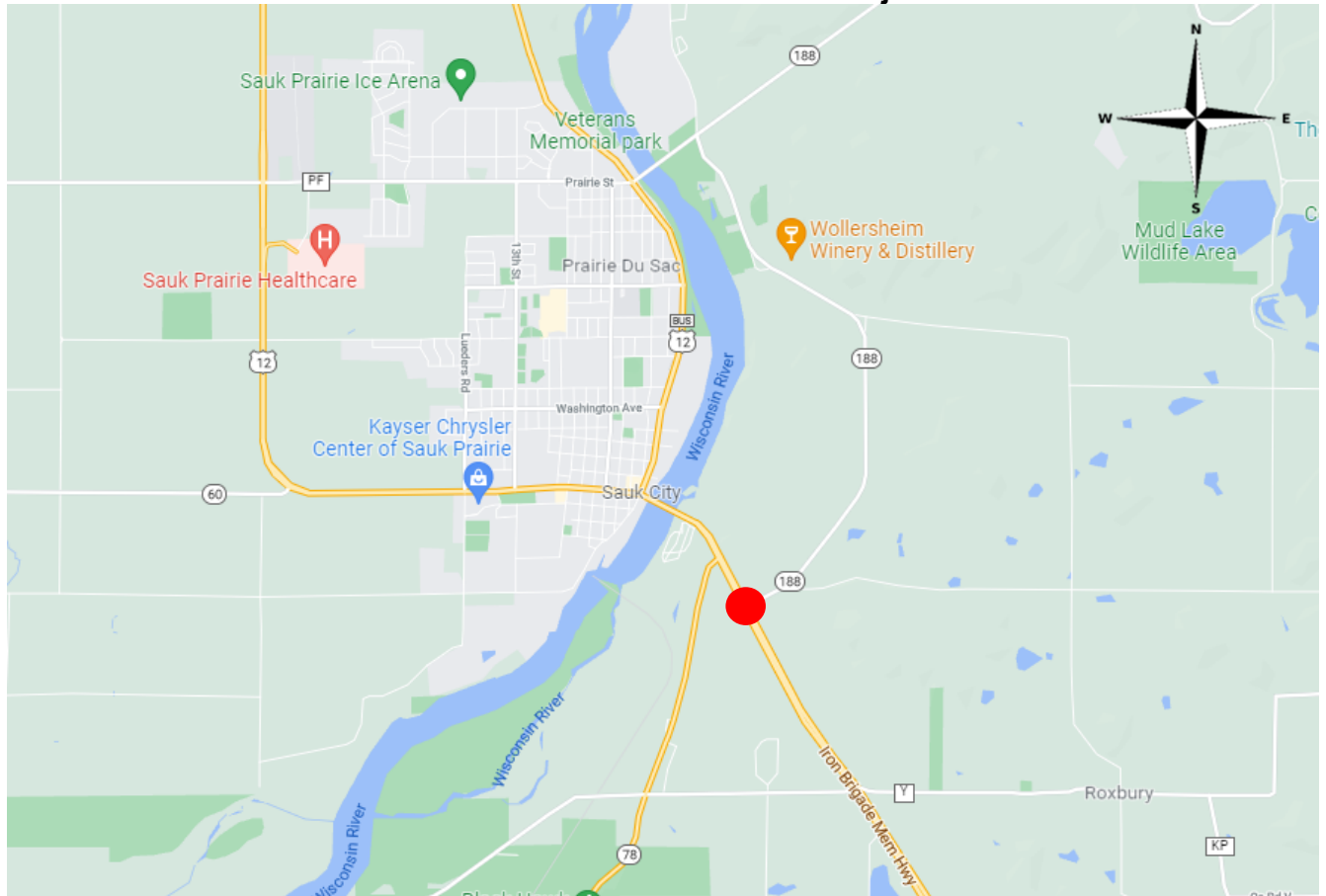
The goal of the public involvement meeting is to inform the public of the projects purpose and need for the project and discuss the preferred alternative. The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) seeks input and feedback through a transparent relationship with local stakeholders. A local official meeting was held virtually on September 28, 2022. The in-person public involvement meeting will start with a brief presentation at 5:00 p.m. and the remainder of the meeting will follow an open house format. WisDOT staff will be available for questions.

## Project information

WisDOT is proposing to improve the intersection of US 12 and WIS 188/Tetiva Road in the town of Roxbury in Dane County. US 12 is a rural 4-lane roadway with a posted speed limit of 55 mph. WIS 188 and Tetiva Road are stop controlled at US 12. There have been 10 crashes recorded at this intersection within five years, and five of those crashes resulted in an injury. Due to the high crash rate at this intersection, there is proposed Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) funding available to improve the safety of this intersection.

The preferred alternative for this intersection is the installation of a traffic signal. A traffic signal would provide controlled movements through the intersection and would be coordinated with the traffic signal at US 12 and WIS 78 to avoid backups. The project will also realign the multiuse path so that it crosses at the light which will improve their visibility to cars.

## Proposed traffic impacts

Construction is currently scheduled to begin in 2026.

During construction the intersection will be open to traffic. The anticipated staging of construction activities will be shared closer to final design. If any temporary driveway closures are necessary during the construction process, WisDOT will contact homeowners and businesses in advance.

## Real estate

Additional right of way may be required for this project. Right of way acquisition is expected to be minimal. WisDOT expects to begin real estate acquisition in fall 2023.

## Project update/next steps

- Public involvement meeting #2: October 6, 2022
- Real estate acquisition starts: Fall 2023
- Final design plans: August 2025
- Construction: Summer 2026

More public involvement will occur as the project moves toward construction.


