

WIS 44 Bridge Replacement Project

Columbia County

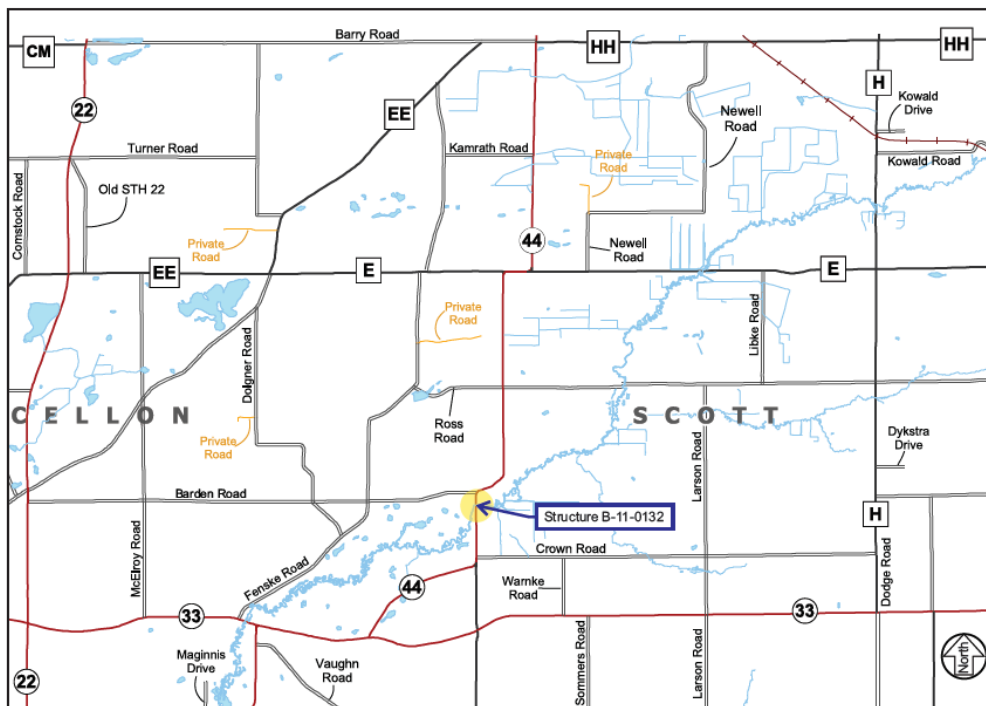

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is proposing to replace the WIS 44 Fox River Structure (B-11-0132) located in Columbia County.

Proposed project details:

- Replace twin 12-foot x 7.5-foot culvert pipes with a 70-foot 2-span flat slab bridge
- Replace roadway pavement 500 feet on each side of the structure
- Raise the roadway profile approximately one foot
- Replace and upgrade the guardrail
- Right of way acquisition may be required

Project location:



Traffic impacts:

- WIS 44 will be closed and require a detour during construction.
- The detour route will include WIS 33, WIS 73, and WIS 44.
- Construction is anticipated to take approximately three months.

Project schedule:

March 2021 – September 2021:
Complete preliminary design and coordination with all agencies and stakeholders

September 2021 – August 2023:
Complete final design and right of way acquisition

August 2023:
Submit final design
