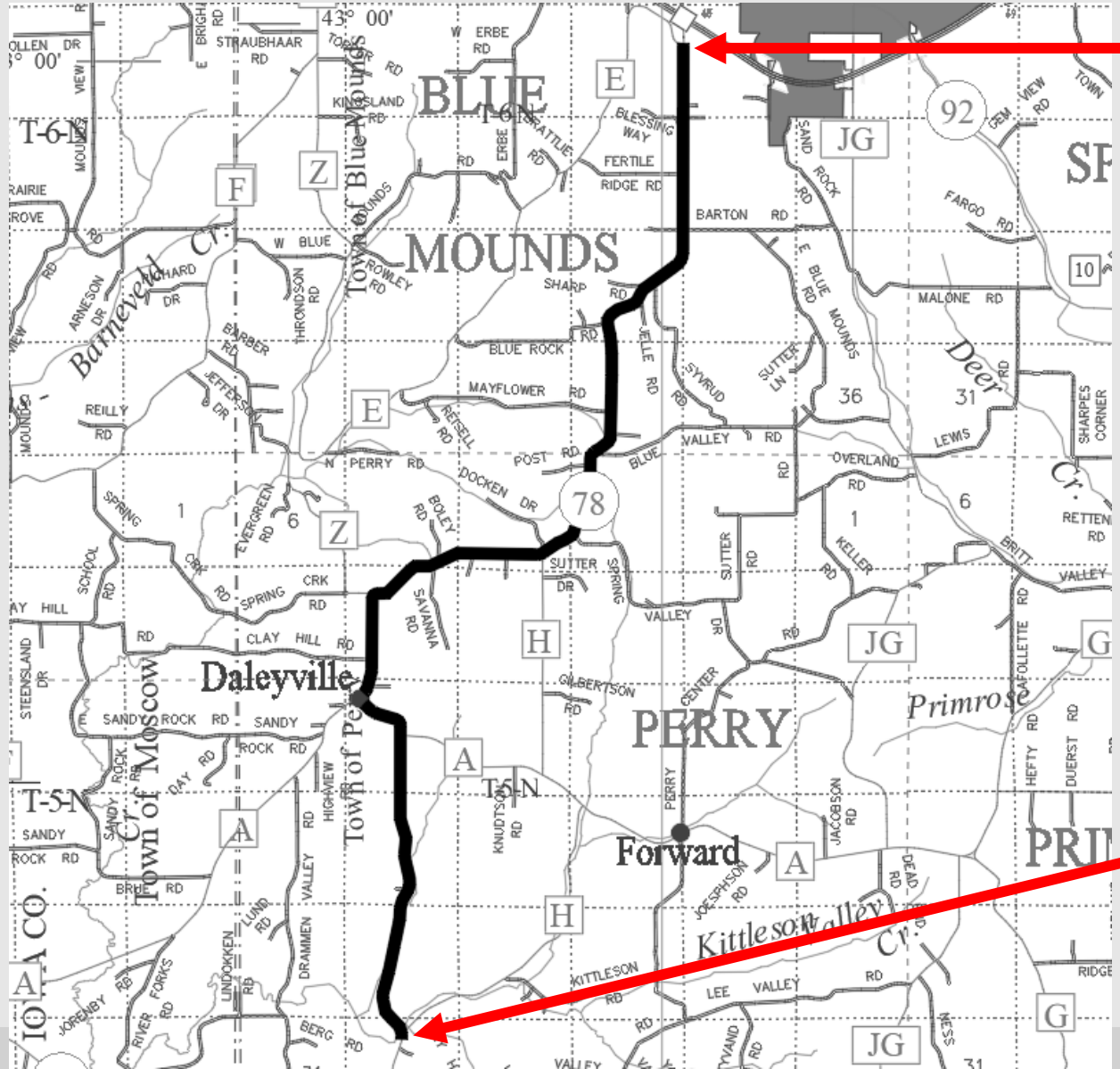

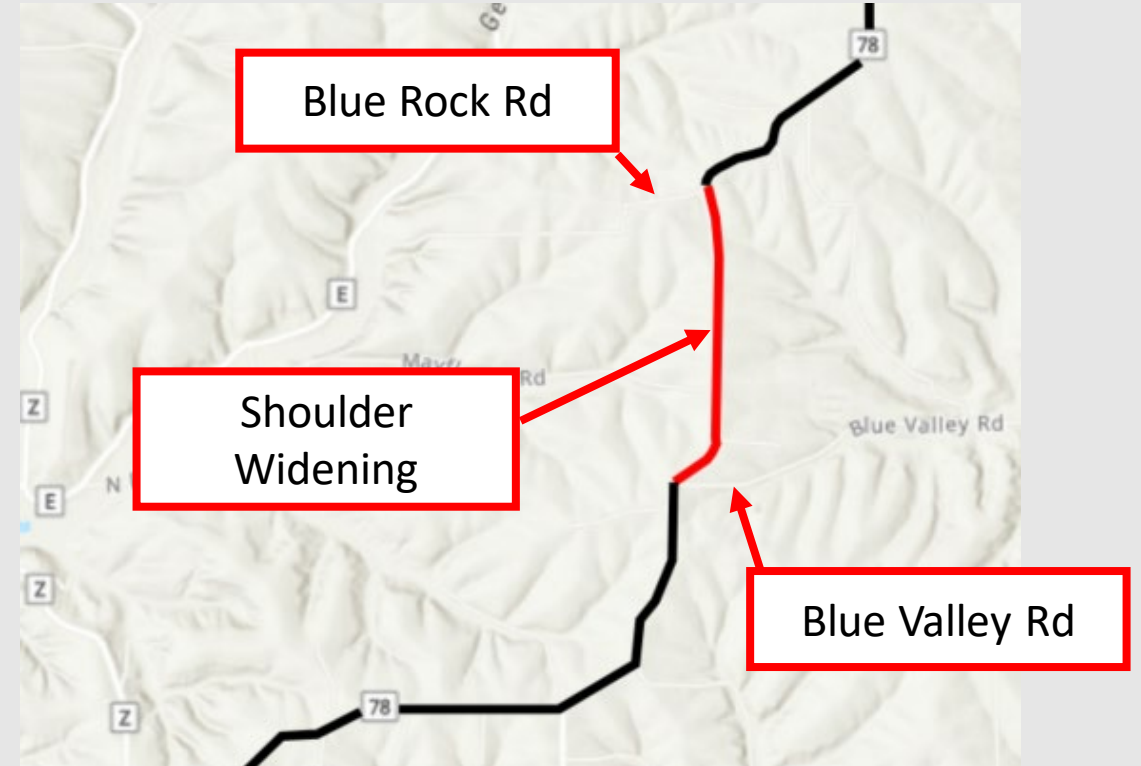

# Project Purpose & Need

## Shoulder widening

- 2016-2020 Crash Analysis
  - 6 crashes
    - 3 Property Damage (All determined to be from failure to control Motor Vehicle)
    - 3 other crashes that had passenger injuries





# Project purpose & need

## Box culvert widening for wider shoulders



# Proposed improvements

- Resurfacing of existing pavement
- Replace curb ramps at WIS 78 and Evergreen Ave
- Replace guardrail along WIS 78
- Widening of box culverts
- Widening of shoulders in safety concern area

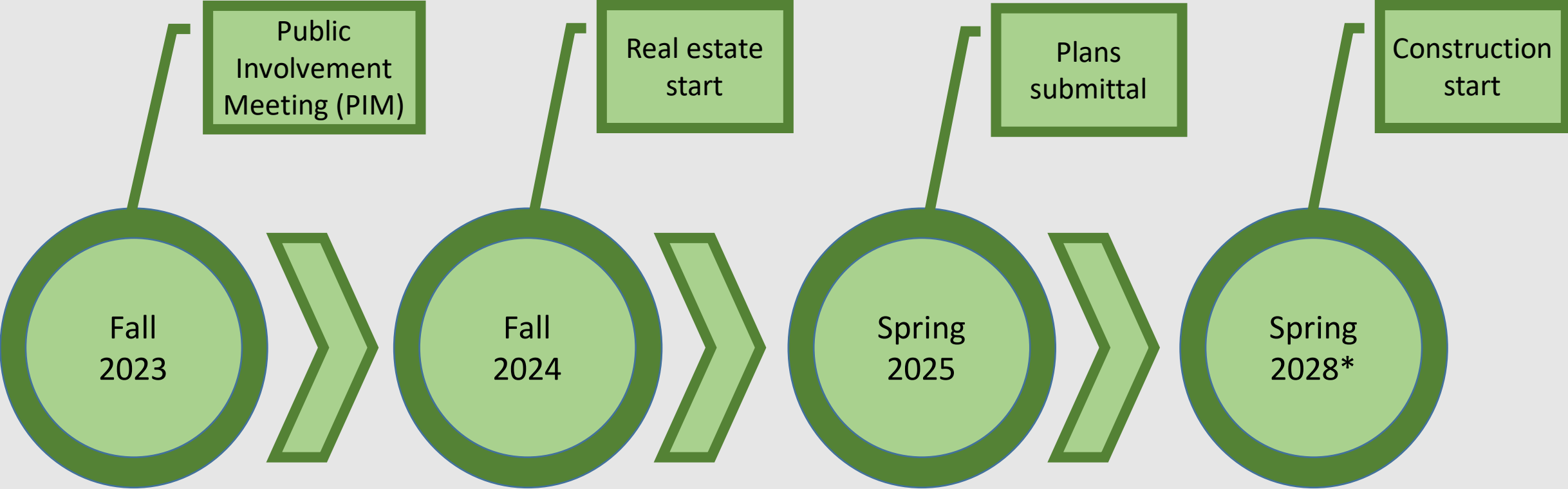


# WIS 78 traffic during construction

- Traffic will be reduced to one lane utilizing flagging operations
  - Maintain access to all properties along roadway
  - Fully open to traffic at end of day
- Short Duration Detours during Culvert Widening work
- Sidewalks with curb ramp construction will be closed during construction activity
