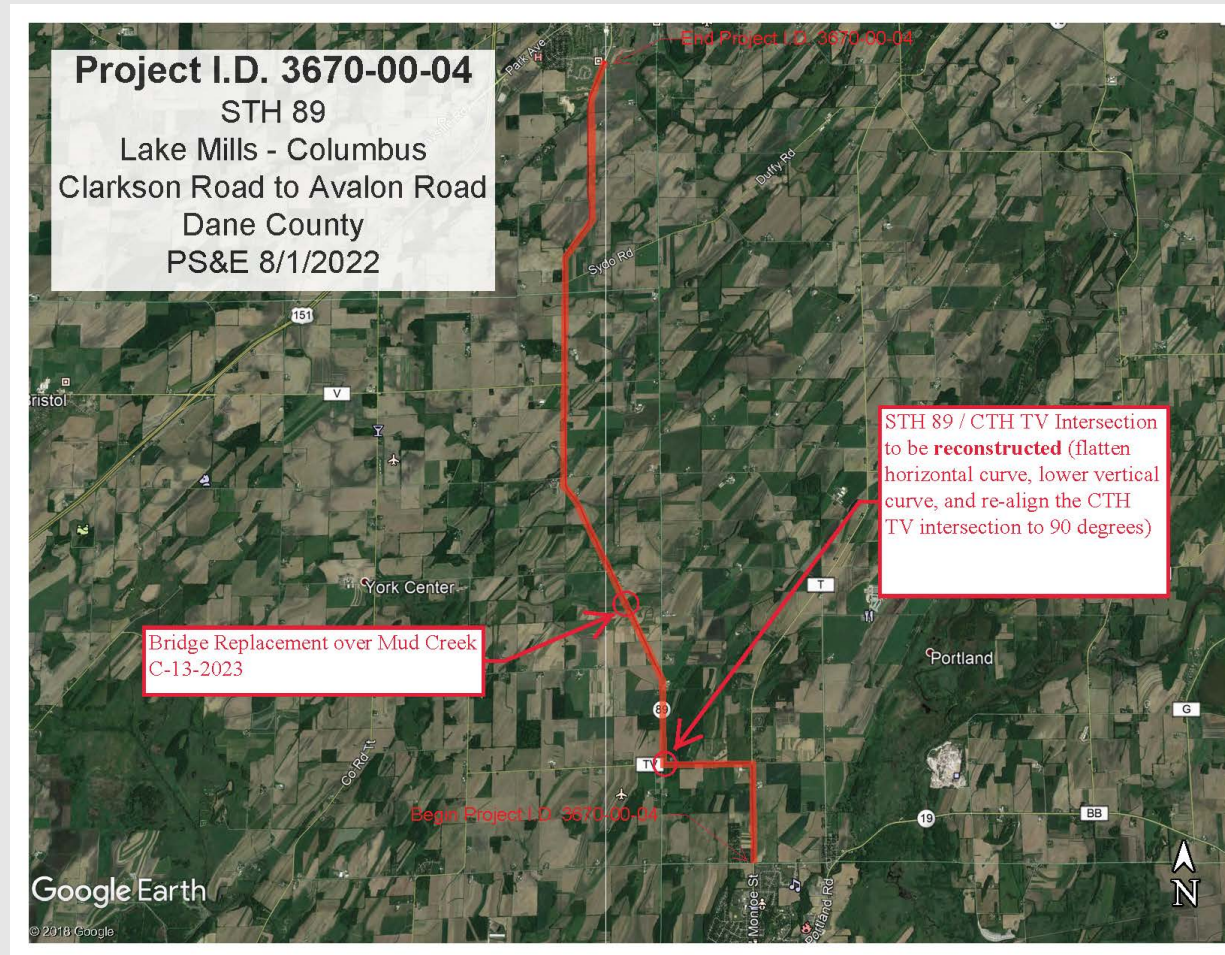

Purpose of Public Involvement

Project Location



Project Purpose

- Address deteriorating pavement surface, improve ride quality, upgrade drainage structures, and to extend the life of the roadway and to upgrade to current safety standards.



Project Need

- Pavement is deteriorating (pavement condition index in the “poor” category).
- Reconstruction of the WIS 89/County TV intersection is needed improve vision (7 crashes at this location from 2013-2017).
- Mud Creek structure replacement needed to address significant scour and slab delamination.



Project Information

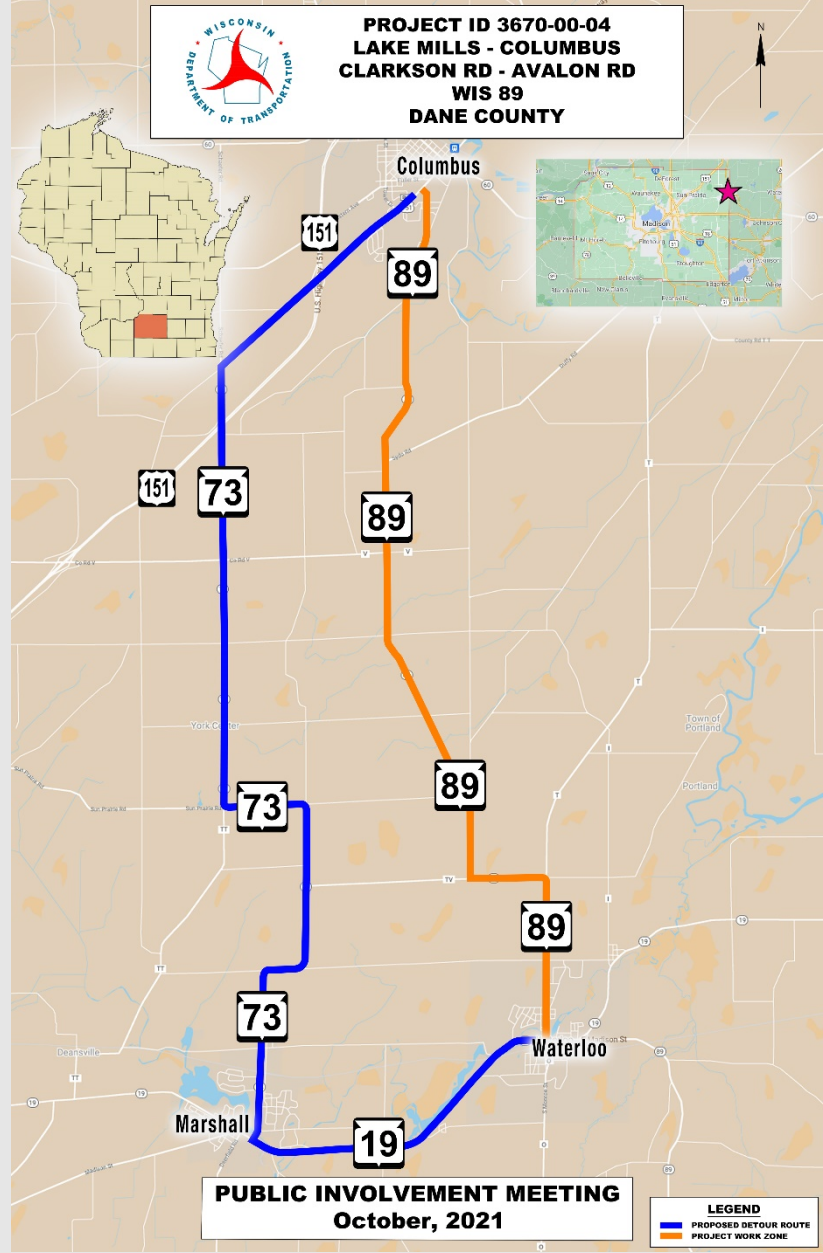
- We are proposing to improve 8 miles of WIS 89 from Clarkson Road (Waterloo) to Avalon Road (Columbus). Proposed improvements consist of the following:
 - Remove the existing pavement and place new asphalt pavement
 - Realign the County TV intersection and flatten the vertical curve
 - Culvert replacements
 - Mud Creek structure replacement including guardrail



Proposed Traffic Impacts

- WIS 89 will be detoured for the duration of the project
- Detour route will include WIS 19 to WIS 73
- Local access will be maintained for residents and businesses





Proposed Traffic Impacts (Cont.)

Real Estate

- Additional right of way will be required for this project
- Preliminary right of way impacts are displayed on the maps available on the project website
- WisDOT anticipates beginning real estate acquisition in fall/winter 2021
 - Coordination will take place with individual property owners
 - Landowner rights brochure is available on the project website



Project Update/Next Steps

- Preliminary design and plans: November 2021
- Right of way acquisition: Fall 2021 to Summer 2022
- Final plans: Summer 2023
- WisDOT construction: 2024
