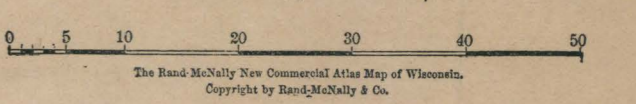


WISCONSIN HIGHWAY COMMISSION

EXPLANATION

The wide red lines on this map show the principal main traveled highways forming through routes of inter-county travel.

The solid narrow red lines show the secondary main lines of travel.

The dotted narrow red lines indicate secondary lines of travel of doubtful passability at certain seasons. Before trying any of these routes, local inquiry as to their condition should be made.

The routes outlined on this map are believed to be the best practicable, and most commonly used between the various points. Wherever inaccuracies or improper routings are indicated on this map, corrections will be appreciated.
