Special Provisions

2. Prosecution and Progress.

Replace the first four paragraphs with the following:

Begin work within 10 calendar days after the engineer issues a written notice to do so.

Construct the project entirely within the 2023 or 2024 construction season. The project must be started and completed in entirety in either calendar year. Provide the intended construction year to the engineer in writing within a month after the contract award.

Provide the time frame for construction of the project within the 2023 or 2024 construction season to the engineer in writing at least 14 calendar days before the preconstruction conference. Assure that the time frame is consistent with the contract completion time. Upon approval, the engineer will issue the notice to proceed within ten calendar days before the beginning of the approved time frame.

To revise the time frame, submit a written request to the engineer at least two weeks before the beginning of the intended time frame. The engineer will approve or deny that request based on the conditions cited in the request and its effect on the department's scheduled resources.

If work is to begin in 2023, the Notice to Proceed will be issued such that work shall start no later than July 20, 2023, unless otherwise approved by the engineer.

If work is to begin in 2024, the Notice to Proceed will be issued such that work shall start no sooner than June 10, 2024, and start no later than July 19, 2024, unless otherwise approved by the engineer.

34. Removing Fence.

Add the following to standard spec 204.3.1.3:

Removed fencing material is to be retained by the adjacent property owner. Remove fencing with care to not damage posts, rails, fabric, or connections. After removal, roll the fence in bundles and place on the property owner's property.
